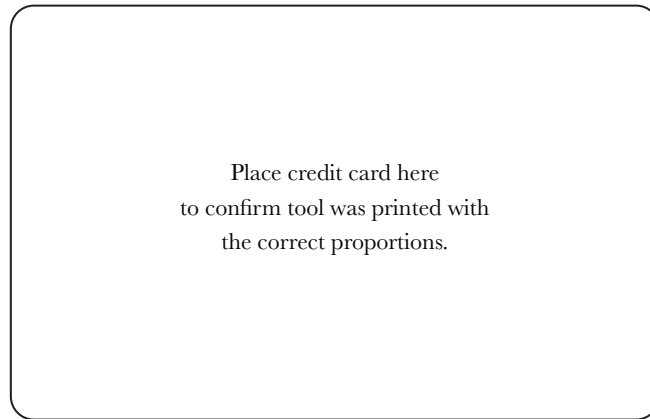

RING SIZING GUIDE

Please set this guide to 100% scale and print it on an A4 paper, then use the ruler to find the right size for you. You can place a credit card or a bank card on the rectangle below to verify your accuracy of the printed dimensions. If the length of the card fits in the rectangle below to verify the accuracy of the printed dimensions. If the length of the card fits in the rectangle, the scaling is accurate.



Measure with a Ring

1. Take a ring you own, one that fits you perfectly.
2. Place it flat on the top of the circles below.
3. Go from the smallest circle until the pink area fills up the inside of the ring perfectly.



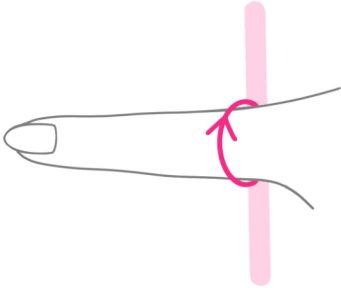
Tip: If you are hesitating between two sizes, choose the larger one.



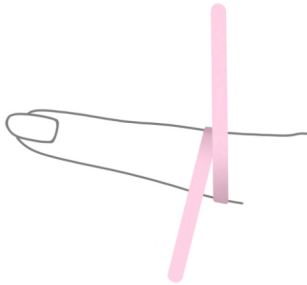

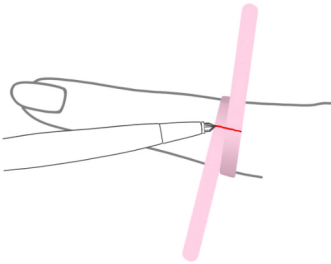
Measure without a Ring



1. Take string or ribbon at least 10 cm long.



2. Using it's length wrap it around the base of your finger. To ensure the ring fits comfortably, we suggest measuring your knuckles as well.



3. With a pen mark the point on the string or ribbon where the ends meets.



4. Your ring size is the measurement in millimeters of your finger's circumference. Simply refer to the pink circles above and the number in mm is your ring size.

Tip: If you are hesitating between two sizes, choose the larger one.

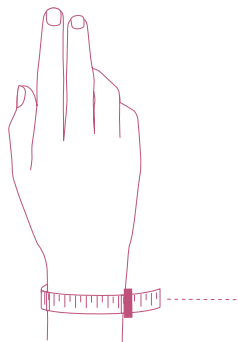
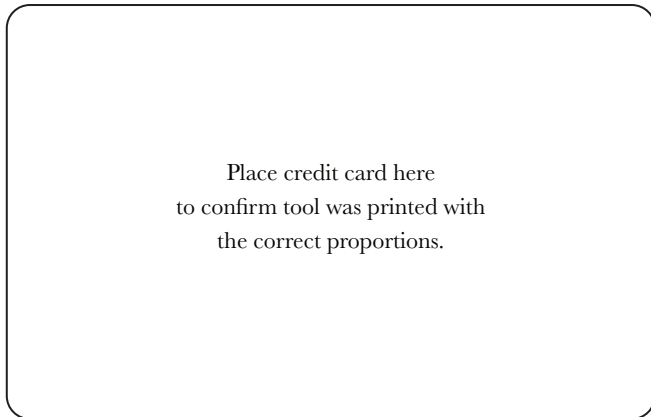

BRACELET SIZING GUIDE

To determine your bracelet size, we strongly advise that you measure the size of your wrist rather than the size of another bracelet.

Please set this guide to 100% scale and print it on A4 paper, then use the ruler to find the right size for you. You can put a credit card or bank card on the rectangle below to verify the accuracy of the printed dimensions. If the length of the card fits in the rectangle, the scaling is accurate



Using the K&Co Paper Sizer

1. Cut out the paper sizer with care.
2. Place your paper sizer around the wrist. To ensure a comfortable bracelet fit, we recommend measuring the thickest part of the wrist, usually the wrist joint.
3. The number indicated by the arrows is the wrist size.
4. We recommend adding one centimeter for a loose fit.
5. Refer to the size chart at the bottom of this page. Match the wrist size you measured using the paper sizer (first column, "wrist size") to find your correct size.
